Once again this year the Archbishop is asking the church to have a time of prayer between Ascension Day and Pentecost. To that end this **Wednesday 24th May** we will have a further day of prayer and fasting concluding with an evening of Worship and Prayer from 8pm and in the days ensuing an interactive prayer space for all the family in The Chapel. Our theme for prayers is light and you may like to consider displaying a candle or small light in your windows during the 10 days of prayer as a public sign that you are praying for God's light in our community. There is a prayer booklet available in the foyer with a sheet detailing all the activities during these days up to Pentecost.
