<u>Our Young People Need You</u> - Here at St Andrew's we believe in the importance of investing in our young people, but this is not just the role of the youth pastor or a select few (amazing) volunteers, but the whole church has a responsibility in nurturing our young people in faith. As the African proverb says, 'It takes a whole village to raise a child'. There are several opportunities available to get to know the young people and encourage them in their faith:

- **Host a meal for Breakout** Could you host the Breakout young people (14-18's) for a meal at your home? This is an easy way to get to know the young people and for them to get to know you. **Dates: Thursday** 5th October or Thursday 2nd November.
- **Help run 'Toasties'** 'Toasties' is a group for 13-18 year olds, held once a month on Sunday from 5-6.15pm in the lounge before café church. As the name suggests we have toasties and hang out before heading into the evening service together. If you go to the evening service could you arrive a bit earlier and help run this group once a month or on a rota basis? It involves eating food and chatting to young people! **Dates: 8**th **October, 12**th **November, 10**th **December.**
- **Mentoring** Could you commit to meeting up with a young person once a month to encourage them personally and spiritually? We would love all our young people to have a mentor!
- **Weekly groups** We need more volunteers for Acts (Tuesdays 7-8.30pm in the Bridge), Breakout (Thursdays 7.30-9.30pm in the Lounge) and Sunday Acts & Breakout (alongside the morning service in the Lounge). Whether you have time to help every week, or just once a month your support will be greatly valued!
