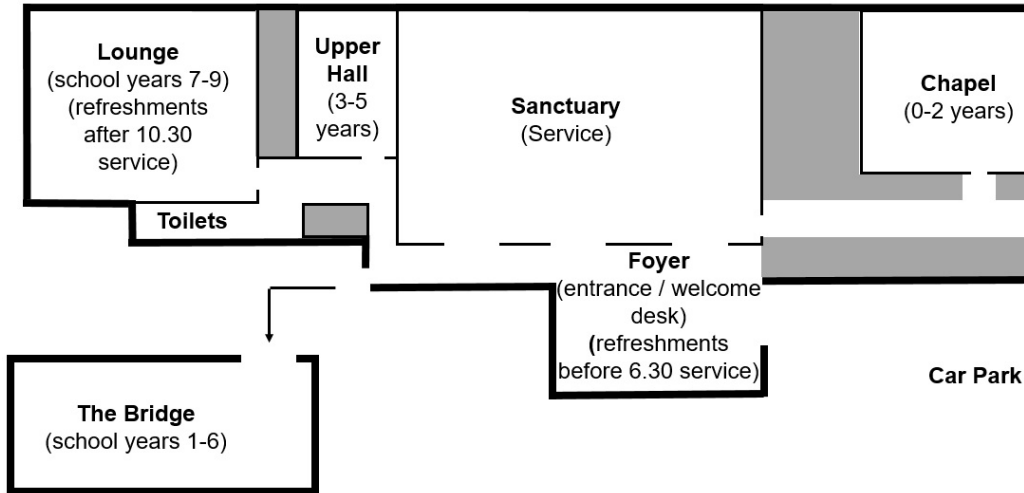


## What's on where during our Sunday Services...
