

ASSISTANT YOUTH PASTOR

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES AND TASKS

1. To identify and prioritise opportunities created by the church's recent acquisition of the Hillside Centre...
 - for establishing and building relationships with young people
 - for connecting in new ways with the wider youth community locally
 - To develop and implement a 3 year plan for use of the Hillside Centre Youth Club. That plan, which will begin by pioneering a mid week group and go on to see the space open throughout the week. will need to be signed off by St Andrew's Youth Pastor prior to implementation and will need to be fully consistent with St Andrew's broader youth vision.
2. To provide support to St Andrew's Youth Pastor, as directed by her, in the design and delivery of discipleship programmes and outreach events within existing frameworks. This would include:

Exploring opportunities for growing youthwork on Sunday evenings and considering follow on opportunities.

Facilitating afterschool 1:1 or Small group mentoring opportunities enabling discipleship growth that goes beyond groups

Building upon the existing Youth Worship Nights at the Hillside Centre – (Currently once per month on Sat nights)

Looking for opportunities to connect with national and diocesan youth events and facilitate an annual Youth Weekend away and occasional trips.
3. To comply fully with all relevant St Andrew's policies and guidelines including (and especially) those covering safeguarding, data protection, health and safety
