You bring creativity and insight to your work balanced by having good judgement and decision-making. Your spiritual maturity and self-awareness allows you to demonstrate pastoral skills and to act with honesty and integrity.

KNOWLEGE

- Safeguarding policy and practice.
- Theology and/or youth work theory and practice.
- Structure and operation of Churches or similar organisations.

EXPERIENCE AND QUALIFICATIONS

- Working with young people in formal and informal settings (including Christian youth work).
- Implementation of strategy and/or projects.
- Successful work in collaboration.
- Familiarity with a range of social media channels.
- Degree level or equivalent qualification desirable but not essential.
- Engagement in continued professional development or other personal development relating to young people.
